Using MS Teams and the Virtual Wormhole

The first time you connect to the Virtual Wormhole:

- 1) Start by logging on to MS Teams. You may need to download an app. You can get started with MS Teams at OSU at https://is.oregonstate.edu/teams.
- 2) Once you're on MS Teams, join the Introductory Physics team. You can enter the team code **23m4foc** or use this link.

Once you're connected to the Introductory Physics Team:

- 3) Go to the <u>Virtual Wormhole channel</u>. From now on you can go to this channel directly. The link is also available through the <u>Wormhole web page</u>.
- 4) Using MS Teams and the Virtual Wormhole:
 - Once you're in the <u>Virtual Wormhole channel</u>, you can post messages to everyone else who's there. There can be a lot going on there.
 - To discuss a specific problem with a group of people:
 - Launch your own Zoom. There you can video chat and share screens. Simply click on the camera icon below the message window.
 - Start a message thread.
 - Respond to an existing thread.
 - If you commonly work with the same people, create a direct message group in the left window. Once created, you can click on the group to send messages only to this group of people.
 - To ask for help, submit a request using the queue. Instructions are given separately. Requests will be addressed in the order that they're posted.
