

Using MS Teams and the Virtual Wormhole

The first time you connect to the Virtual Wormhole:

- 1) Start by logging on to MS Teams. You may need to download an app. You can get started with MS Teams at OSU at <https://is.oregonstate.edu/teams>.
- 2) Once you're on MS Teams, join the Introductory Physics team. You can enter the team code **23m4foc** or use [this link](#).

Once you're connected to the Introductory Physics Team:

- 3) Go to the [Virtual Wormhole channel](#). From now on you can go to this channel directly. The link is also available through the [Wormhole web page](#).
- 4) Using MS Teams and the Virtual Wormhole:
 - Once you're in the [Virtual Wormhole channel](#), you can post messages to everyone else who's there. There can be a lot going on there.
 - To discuss a specific problem with a group of people:
 - Start a message thread.
 - Respond to an existing thread.
 - If you commonly work with the same people, create a direct message group in the left window. Once created, you can click on the group to send messages only to this group of people.
 - Use the Wormhole Zoom session to collaborate; the link is a tab at the top of the channel. The session has breakout pages for each course. In Zoom you can video chat and share screens. Simply click on the camera icon below the message window.
 - To ask for help, submit a request using the queue. Instructions are given separately. Requests will be addressed in the order that they're posted.
